\* Bell's wireless subscriber base increased by 476,932 subscribers as a result of the acquisition of MTS on March 17, 2017.

Subsequently, in Q2, 2017, Bell's wireless subscriber base was reduced to reflect the estimated divestiture of postpaid subscribers to TELUS as a condition of that transaction. As a result, although Q2 Net Additions and Total Subscribers to Date do not add up for these companies, the Total Subscribers to Date are correct.

In Q4, 2017, Telus revised downward the total number of estimated subscribers migrating from MTS by 11,000. As a result, although Q4 Net Additions and Total Subscribers to Date do not add up for Telus, the Total Subscribers to Date is correct.

\*\* To provide a more meaningful reflection of the underlying performance of its wireless business in Q4 2017, Rogers reduced its wireless postpaid subscriber base by 207,000 subscribers to remove a low-ARPU public services customer that is in the process of migrating to another service provider.
